

NOTICE OF RACE SNIPE CLASS INTERNATIONAL RACING ASSOCIATION USA



Colonial Cup Invitational Severn Sailing Association June 2-3, 2018 Annapolis, MD

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:

Severn Sailing Association and Annapolis Snipe Fleet 532 in co-operation with Snipe Class International Racing Association USA.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by:
 - a. The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the prescriptions of US Sailing.
 - b. The SCIRA Rules of Conduct For Conducting National and Local Regattas (RoC).
 - c. The Sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Advertising is permitted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 and SCIRA rules.
- 2.2. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1. This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and Class Member skippers
- 3.2. No skipper shall be eligible to enter unless:
 - a. they possess and present a current Class Membership Card, or
 - b. SCIRA-issued equivalent, or
 - c. show as current member in the SCIRA Official Online Database.

4. **REGISTRATION**

- 4.1. Registration for Open, Silver, Junior and Women Division will be available however all boats will race as one fleet.
 - a. Registration in the Silver Division is optional and is intended for less experienced sailors or older boats that are not JibeTech or Persson (i.e., McLaughlin, Eclipse, Mueller, Skipper etc). The organizing authority reserves the right to determine eligible participants.
 - b. Registration in the Junior Division is for junior sailors as defined by SCIRA: under 22 years old (not having their 22nd birthday during the calendar year the regatta is held).
- 4.2. On-Site Registration
 - a. Entries must registered by completing the official entry form at online as described below.
- 4.3. Online registration

5. FEES

- 5.1. Early Registration fees will be \$80.00. Payment of fees must be received by the regatta organizer prior to May 27, 2017 to be eligible.
- 5.2. Registrations received after May 27, 2017 will be \$90.00.

5.3. Registration includes 2 dinner tickets for Saturday night dinner and beverages. Additional dinner tickets may be added to the registration entry for \$25.00 each.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. Registration: Online and 8-9:30 am on Saturday, June 2
- 6.2. Skipper's Meeting: 9:30 am on Saturday, June 2
- 6.3. Schedule of Races:
 - a. 11:00 am on Saturday, First warning signal
 - b. 10:00 am on Sunday, First warning signal
 - c. Six (6) races are scheduled. At the completion of six (6) races there will be one drop.
 - d. No race to start after 14:30pm on Sunday.

7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1. All boats shall have a valid measurement certificate and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee.
- 7.2. All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

9. VENUE

9.1. Races will be sailed on the Chesapeake Bay in area designated by the Race Committee.

10. COURSES

10.1. The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses for Sanctioned regattas as published in the current SCIRA Official Rulebook and SCIRA web site.

11. SCORING

11.1. The low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 12.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.
- 12.2. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. PRIZES

- 14.1. Prizes, at a minimum, will be awarded to the overall regatta winner and for the top skippers and crews in each division
 - a. The Colonial Cup perpetual trophy will be awarded to top placing skipper/crew regardless of division
 - **b.** Top three placing skippers and crews registered in the Open division
 - c. Top placing skipper and crew registered in the Silver division
 - d. Top placing skipper are crew registered in the Junior division
 - e. Top placing skipper and crew registered in the Women division

Food Services:

SSA has a great new food service vendor operating both on site and at a nearby location on Second Street just a block away.

- The snack bar at SSA will be open Saturday and Sunday for breakfast from 8-10:30. It will reopen in the afternoon around 2 for beverages and food.
- Deli sandwiches are available for purchase in the morning at the Snack Bar for those wishing to take lunch with them.

Bread and Butter Kitchen also offers breakfast and lunch from 7:30-3PM daily at their cafe, which is just one block over (a 3-4 minute walk) on Second Street. In addition to their regular menu, they also offer Crew Lunches, which include your choice of sandwich, their housemade chips, fruit, and cookies. Directions to Severn Sailing Association: Directions: From Points North take I-97 South to US 50 East. Take Exit 24, Rowe Blvd (MD 70). Bear right onto Rowe Blvd. Cross Weems Creek and College Creek. Continue on Rowe Blvd as it bears right at the 3rd light. At Church Circle go about 180 degrees to Duke of Gloucester Street. The Maryland Inn is on the corner. Follow Duke of Gloucester Street and turn right at end. Cross Spa Creek and take the first left onto Severn Ave. Go the last street and turn left onto First Street. SSA is at the end of the street on the right. The address is 311 First Street, Annapolis, MD 21401.
